Practical Nurse Application Process

If you are not an NPC student, complete the online admissions form. Applicants for the Certificate PN program are chosen using a ranking system. Applicants receive points in the ranking system for the following: TEAS score, certifications, recent work experience in healthcare, and selected college credit. The program admission process is selective.

1. Provide copy of unofficial high school transcript or GED, and unofficial college transcript from colleges previously attended. Transcripts must be attached to your application.
2. Take College Entrance test if required or provide copy of SAT or ACT test results. A copy of the Accuplacer, Compass Test, SAT or ACT test results must be attached to your application. If college course is completed in the last three years, test score requirement is waived.
3. Complete PN Application & attach applicable transcripts (see step 1 & 2). Make sure to answer the questions on the back of the application. *Prior to enrollment, all official college transfer credit must be on file with the registrar.*
4. Provide verification of certifications such as: CNA, EMT, Paramedic, etc...
5. Provide verification of employment (if applicable). Work experience must be within the calendar year.
6. Pay for the ATI TEAS (Test of Essential Academic Skills) at the NPC Business Office. Cost of the TEAS test is \$58. This test is a requirement for nursing admissions. **ATI TEAS scores are valid for 2 consecutive application periods.**
7. Bring your nursing application along with the attached documents and your receipt for the TEAS test to the nursing secretary.
8. Register for one of the TEAS testing sessions held by the Division of Nursing. Advising will be available following the testing. Applicants for the PN Program will be awarded ranking points for reading and Math based on the TEAS test. If you register to test and fail to attend, there will be an additional \$20 charge to reschedule. If you absolutely cannot test on one of the Division dates, NPC testing center may be available to assist you, depending on seats available.
 - a. To take the TEAS test, you must create an account. Prior to your test date, please go to https://np.edu/academics/nursing-division/2018_teastestdateinstructions.pdf Remember your user name and password.

9. All paperwork and testing is to be completed and returned to PN Office by the first Monday in March.
