A Resolution In Support Of NPCC Millage Increase

WHEREAS, NPCC is a comprehensive community college with students ranging in age from 16-86;

WHEREAS, More than 100 area business use the college for industry- specific training programs;

WHEREAS, NPCC is one of the largest employers in Garland County;

WHEREAS, NPCC will request a 1.7 mill increase in millage from the voters of Garland County in April of 2013;

WHEREAS, an increase in local funding will enable NPCC to improve infrastructure, create new classrooms, workshops, and opportunities;

WHEREAS, a better educated workforce will lead to improved economic conditions and increased job opportunities for the students and citizens of Garland County;

WHEREAS, with the total of 2.5 mills NPCC will create a new Workforce Training Center, High School Technical Center, and Post-Secondary Technical Training Center

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, in consideration of the best interest of the student body, that the NPCC Student Government Association does hereby pledge their support of the NPCC millage increase.
